Cold/Flu Season: Cold and Flu season is now in session. reminder Washington State Health Policy REQUIRES , if your child has a fever, diarrhea, or infectious disease that your child stay home for 24 hours after symptoms subside. For example if your child's fever breaks at 9:00am then the next day at 9:00am your child can come to school. If they still have a symptoms, it is 24 hours after the fever, diarrhea, infectious disease has ended. If you have questions then please call before you come into the classroom. Please help to stop the spread of illnesses.

### Snow Days:

In the event of snow, we will follow the Edmonds School District on these decisions. If there is a late start there will be no morning class , but there will be afternoon class. If they have no school, we will have no school. Please visit our website school closure button, which should be updated by 7:30am.

### Parent Conferences:

Please note there is no school on Tuesday 17th and early dismissal of 2:30pm on , Wednesday-Friday, January 19th-21st, as we will be holding parent conferences those days. Sign ups for your twenty minute slot will be sent out upon our return from Christmas break. If you are not free on any of those days, you may sign up for a telephone conference. There is a space on the sign ups for this.

Bus Stop/school zone: We are working with Community Transit and the City of Edmonds to move the proposed bus stop in front of the school and work in a possible school zone signage.. One suggestion from the city after their site visit was to park in 9 spots in our lot if possible, for safety , instead of across the street. We are working to repair the fence, which has recently caused problems with parking. Thanks for your patience with this situation.
